INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

Islamic Relief Kenya (IRK) is an international humanitarian and developmental organization with its headquarters in the UK. IR Kenya's mission is to provide emergency relief, alleviate poverty and suffering. IR started operations in Kenya in 1993 through a local CBO in Mandera District, Northern Kenya. It opened its fully-fledged office in March 2006 at the height of drought in the Horn of Africa. Since then, it has been providing humanitarian and development assistance to vulnerable communities. Over the years IRK has remarkably changed the lives of the vulnerable and disadvantaged communities. In January 2010 and October 2011, IRK extended its operation to Wajir and Garissa County; to serve both the local community and Refugee at Dadaab Camp. Islamic Relief also operates in Moyale, Kajiado and Kilifi Counties.

Islamic Relief Kenya is currently focusing on three major goal/themes i.e. Sustainable Community
Empowerment (around areas of Health and Nutrition; WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene); Sustainable
Livelihoods and Disaster Risk reduction (DRR); Disaster and Humanitarian Response and Education and Child
Development. Since 2006 IRK has remarkably changed the lives of the vulnerable and disadvantaged
communities. Following this great success in Mandera, most of the programmes and best practices have been,
and continue to be replicated in other parts of the country, mostly in Northern Kenya. For instance, in January
2010, IRK extended its operation to Wajir County, neighboring Mandera. In 2011, the programme was extended
to Garissa and Dadaab and in 2012, to Nairobi Slums (Korogocho slums). In 2018, IRK opened offices in
Moyale, Kajiado and Kilifi to replicate its best practices in supporting and empowering communities.

IRK is thus dedicated and committed to the reconstruction of communities through direct contact with the locals and effective programming thus positively contributing towards improving the living standards and conditions of target beneficiaries.

IRK is planning to undertake the procurement of live sheep/goats for Aqiqah and Adak Project program to support needy households in Garissa County

No tender shall be rejected at the tender opening except for late tenders. Tenders not opened and read out at the tender opening shall not be considered further for evaluation, irrespective of the circumstances.

Prices quoted should be inclusive of all taxes, must be in Kenya shillings and shall remain valid for (60) days from the closing date of tender.

Instructions

Bidders are strongly advised to carefully read all instructions and respond appropriately. Failure to comply with these instructions will result in the rejection of the bid.

1. Scope:

- a) Supply and Delivery of Aqiqah live sheep and goats to vulnerable communities in Garissa County
- b) The quote should include the costs for supply, packaging, branding, and delivery to specific distribution sites.
- d) Successful suppliers are required to deliver the Aqiqah live sheep and goats to the designated distribution sites, where Islamic Relief staff will distribute them to the intended rightsholders.

2. Eligible Bidders

The invitation for the bids is open to all interested eligible Companies/individuals who are duly registered and in possession of valid documents.

3. The live Aqiqah Goats and sheep being supplied must meet the following criteria:

- a) Must be at least 18 months and above
- b) Must be at least 15 Kgs and above

- c) Must be complete without any abnormality
- d) Goats must meet all the criteria/standards which are as follows:
- e) The animals eligible are 9 female (She) goats and 1male (He) goat per Household.
- f) Should not be blind or mono mono-eyed full ears with no defects at all.
- g) Should not be physically disabled and have a deformity of any kind (i.e., it should not even have broken horns)
- h) Should be fat, healthy, and strong.
- i) Animals MUST be recently Vaccinated and Dewormed
- j) Animals that have no teeth at all are not eligible. If an animal has lost some teeth only and has most of its teeth. If most of the teeth are lost, it is not eligible.

3. Services

All services to be done under the contract. IR Kenya contracts supplier(s) to deliver the required Aqiqah live sheep and goats as indicated in the voucher to the beneficiary's localities.

4. Cost of Bidding

The bidders shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid & IRK will in no case be responsible for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

5. Clarification of Bidding Documents

7. Amendment of Bidding Document

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, IRK May for any reason, at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by the prospective bidder, modify the bidding documents & will be binding on them. The amendment will be notified in writing all prospective bidders who have received the bidding documents & will be binding on them. To allow prospective bidders to take the amendment into account in preparing their bids, IRK may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for bid submission.

8. Language of the Bid

The bid prepared by the bidder, as well as all correspondence & documents relating to the bid, supporting documents, and printed literature furnished by the bidder, shall be written in English language.

9. Bid Currencies

The bid prices shall be quoted in Kenya Shillings (KES).

10. Bids Prices

- The potential contractor shall submit his/her bid as indicated in Annex I.
- The bidders shall indicate the price per goat and the total bid price.

Prices quoted by the bidder shall be fixed for *Sixty* (60) calendar days from the date of Tender opening. Price changes during the bid validity period after the contract award will not be accepted

11. Delivery

Delivery to be within Thirty (30) days of signing the contract

12. IRK's right to vary quantities at the time of the award

IRK reserves the right at the time of the award of contract to increase or decrease by up to 10% without change in the price per goat/sheep or other terms of condition.

13. IRK's right to accept any bid and/or reject any or all bids

IRK reserves the right to accept any bid and to annul the bidding processes and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without, thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders on the grounds of its action.

14. Submission of Bids

The bidders shall submit their bids in one envelope marked with Tender Name and Reference. Bidder to sign a bid receipt form upon return/submission of bid to IRK.

15. Evaluation

- 15.1 IRK will examine the prequalification documents to determine completeness, general orderliness, sufficiency in responsiveness, price, and product brand.
- 15.2 The potential suppliers shall not contact IRK on matters relating to their bid from the time of opening to completion and official communication sent to them. Any effort by the potential supplier to influence IRK in the evaluation shall result in disqualification.
- 15.3 Prequalification will be based on meeting the minimum criteria regarding the applicant's legal status, general and particular experience, personnel, and financial position as demonstrated by their responses as set in clause 8.
- 15.4 The applicants <u>MUST</u> have registered offices and IRK reserves the discretion of visiting physical premises from which the applicant conducts business if so desired to confirm the existence and capability to deliver the assorted items.
- 15.5 Due diligence shall be undertaken, and any bidder found to be in breach by providing false information shall be disqualified.

16. Employment of Minors

The supplier shall not employ children carrying out the contract. The Contractor shall observe international conventions relating to child labor, namely the UN Convention No.182 on the worst forms of child labor and Convention No. 138 on the minimum age for admission to employment.

17. Criminal Act

The supplier undertakes to comply with all applicable laws and to ensure that it does not engage in any kind of criminal activity including but not limited to bribery, fraud, corruption,

terrorism and to maintain ethical business practices as well as not to commit any Prohibited Acts defined as:

- 1. To offer, promise or give any person a financial or other advantage.
- 2. To request, agree to receive or accept any financial or other advantage not expressly provided for as an inducement or a reward for the performance of any function or activity in connection with this Agreement.
